
HEPP first in FIRST AID





DIN 13 167 First-aid bag for motorcycles Description of product







Although the carrying of first-aid bags on motorcycles is not yet a legal requirement in Germany, there is already an appropriate standard, DIN 13 167, which specifies the contents. First-aid materials are required for slight injuries as well as for emergencies. The practical HEPP "emergency kit" also helps motorbike, scooter and moped riders provide first-aid to others in need.

First-aid bag for motorcycles (Ref. No. 41000)

• Contents: Comply with the applicable standard DIN 13167

• Material: Outer cover made from high quality nylon with

water-repellent PVC coating, zip fastener

• Colours: Red or black; imprint: contrasting colours

• Dimensions: Approx. W 195 x H 135 x D 40 mm

• Weight: Approx. 0.3 kg


• Information: The DIN-compliant contents are protected

against dust in a mini-grip bag and the whole bag is protected from moisture inside a further bag. The first-aid material should always be kept up to date, especially in Germany where pro-

viding first-aid is a legal obligation.

version with dimensions of approximately W 160 x H 120 x D 40 mm; special imprints/colours with company logos are available.
